The powerful and transforming effects of the Word of God in our lives, is something in which we marvel and delight as serving the Lord here at MITC. The testimonies of God's Grace in action, bringing conviction about sin and submission to the will of God are present in our daily lives. Such is the case of **Omar and Norma Soto**. As teenagers without Christ and His Gospel, they both spiraled down into a lost way of living, alcohol and drug abuse and living on the street in the second biggest city of the world. In God's providence, this teenage couple left Mexico City to look for a "better life" in the United States. Crossing into the country illegally, they made their way up to Indiana to find jobs together. After some time of being in the U.S., the Word of God came to them!

First, Norma received a Gospel Tract with the Scriptures and the Spirit revealed her need of Christ and worked faith and repentance in her heart. Omar saw her brokenness and faith in Jesus and, at first, was offended and made fun of what was happening in Norma's life. He soon realized that something miraculous and transforming had happened and was moved to search the Scriptures and learn about this Savior. Sometime later and after learning about God's salvation by grace by faith alone, he too was born in the family of God. With a hunger to learn the Bible and of the Lord, they studied under the leadership in **Christ Covenant Church** and grew in grace and understanding of God's character and will. This led them to come under conviction about being in the U.S. illegally and they felt that if they were unable to obtain the necessary papers to stay, then they should return to Mexico. By this time, they were established in their U.S. way of life, with two children, a home and a stable income. The decision to follow the Lord's leading was going to be costly. God had been using them in the midst of the church in Indiana and it was evident that there was a special heart of service in these brethren. About this time, they heard through a missionary friend of MITC, of God's work among the peoples and tribes in southwestern Mexico. The desire to serve God in Mexico, along with the decision to honor the Lord by leaving the U.S. (because of their illegal status), brought Omar and Norma to study at MITC. So last August, they sold their home, left their jobs and returned (now with two little boys) to serve God in

Mexico. Omar is in the “full time” program and Norma studies in the Saturday Seminary. We praise the Lord for His Powerful, Living and Life Changing WORD. Please keep them in your prayers as they prepare for God’s service.

The Lord allowed Chuy and me to visit the Cuicateco speaking brethren up in **Santa Maria Papalo**. We had a Bible Conference for the village leaders of that region and for the local church. Their love for the Word of God was evident, first of all, by the effort to get there. Many of

the leaders that came from other villages, walked nearly five hours UP the mountain to come learn the Scriptures and have fellowship with other brethren. The ladies of the local church worked for long hours (before sunrise to very late night) to prepare food for everyone attending and make the Conference possible. God’s Word was greatly honored by their love and sacrifice and we were blessed and encouraged by this testimony.

To help us teach the Scriptures, the Lord has given us our campus here at Cordoba, with the necessary facilities to house staff, students and visitors. In a special way, each building contributes



in planting the seeds of the Gospel. We are very grateful for the service of our brethren from **Woodcreek Church**, led by pastor **Bill Brewer** and **Tom Belter**, who came and put a roof on our new “girls dorm apartment”. This place will be used to house one of our growing staff families in the near future. These men from Woodcreek leave their regular jobs in the States (engineers, insurance, pharmacists, pastor, etc...) and become missionary carpenters for

a week. They build and mount trusses, put up sheet metal and then sheetrock the underside of the new roof, all in five days! We praise the Lord for the lives of these dear friends who came and worked intensely to complete the assigned project in the allotted time. They did a great job and the fellowship and camaraderie was also a special blessing. We see their love for the Word of God and how they show it through their desire to help the school continue in its teaching ministry!


