The annual **Vacation Bible School Workshop** was a tremendous event again this year. Teachers from churches from the immediate region and as far away as **Mexico City** came for the intensive four day course led by **Linda Webb** from **Olive Branch, Mississippi**. The program this year, "Digging in the History of the Church", was developed around the history of the Early Church taken from the

book of Acts. This summer, the kids will learn about places and people that God saved and used in the first century. Each day (during the VBS) they will take off on a type of “archeological excursion” and find relics that lead them to a story from places as varied as **Jerusalem, Ephesus,** and all the way to **Rome**. They will see and study the different preachers and responses to the Gospel as it was taken from city to city. One of the purposes is to encourage the children to share of Christ in the many situations they may encounter. Our second year students (who are the main reason for the Workshop) will be staffing and running twelve weeks of VBS in as many churches in the mountains of **Oaxaca** in the month of July. Last year, the VBS program taught and developed here at MITC was used in seventy-two churches in southern Mexico. We pray that the Lord will allow even more this year and that the sound teaching of the Word of God will give much fruit in the hearts of the children for the glory of God. We are very thankful to the Lord for His blessing upon Linda and that, in spite of surgeries and treatments for cancer during the past year, she is willing and able to develop and bring this teaching and all the materials and supplies necessary for our students.

The village churches that the Lord has started through MITC had their annual assembly in the village of **Mogoñe, Oaxaca**. This is a special time when leaders from the churches of the mountains of Oaxaca of the **Cuicateco, Chinanteco** and **Mixe** peoples come together for a time of Bible Conferences and to report to all the other brethren of what God is doing in the different areas. In total, there were about thirty churches represented and the hosts for the assembly this year were the Mixe brethren led by pastors **Victor** and **Felix Castanon** (MITC grad). It was a special time of fellowship and learning as Pastor Mark Webb (Linda’s husband) brought messages from Hebrews chapter 12, on running the Christian race of salvation. God greatly blessed the time as some brethren came from villages fourteen hours distant to be part of the three day assembly. The fourth year

Many students have never seen a dentist until they arrive here for their Bible studies, so Dane had a great work load in order to get the future missionaries, pastors and teachers mouths ready for the ministry! His service is a great blessing also to all the mission staff and families. We are grateful

for the smiles he brings to our faces!

The summer groups have begun and our first two teams were coordinated by Mark Webb from Grace Bible of Olive Branch, Mississippi. God brought this multi-church group together from four churches and four states. **Mississippi, New York, Pennsylvania** and **Alabama** were represented and led by pastors **Nathan Ruble, Mark Edwards** and Mark Webb. United by the common purpose of serving the Lord and His people here in Mexico, they accomplished many work projects and also preached in the area churches and here at the school. We are especially grateful for the series of messages brought by pastor Edwards on “Cruciform Love”, on following the example of our Lord and Savior Jesus, the Great Servant of God.

On a personal note, Chuy and I are very thankful to the Lord for His blessing in providing for our family in His marvelous grace through Christ here at MITC. We want to publicly express our thanksgiving to God for providing for our son **Dan Kirby** to finish his studies in College here in Mexico and graduate as an Industrial Engineer. We are also very thankful to all who pray for us as a family and we would ask you keep Kirby in your prayers that the Lord will guide him in His way.
