We had many very special guests at the graduation this year (over 800), several of our board members from the United States and Mexico, including our former and present Executive Directors: Bill Magee and David Bryant. We are especially grateful to the Lord for giving Brother Bill the strength to make the trip and to Dr. Bo Worley for his care and help in bringing him (B. Magee)

down to be with us. Brother Bill brought back many special memories as he played the harmonica and sang praises to the Lord Jesus. Also attending the graduation and causing our hearts to overflow with joy, was a contingent of seventy **Tlapaneco** brethren led by former graduates, pastors and missionaries in the mountains of the state of **Guerrero**. In this group of brethren were also twenty-three students from the Tlapaneco Bible School, which is completely staffed by MITC graduates. So it was truly like having the "children of our children" who are "walking in the truth" at this special time of celebration. One particular family from the mountains of Guerrero was present and deserves special notice. **The Silva family** and the two older brothers **Alejandro** and **Galo**, are both graduates from past generations (classes of 1993 and 2006). This year, the youngest of the three, **Jesus "Chucho" Silva,** graduated and goes to join his two older brothers in the Lord's work in the remote areas of Guerrero. Each of these young men in different moments of their ministries, have already suffered hardships for the Gospel of Christ among the Tlapaneco people. We thank the Lord for His grace in their lives and for their walk in the Truth for the glory of Christ.

To help us get the campus ready for Graduation, we had the help of the work group from Summer Grove Baptist, led by Cecil and Sissy Snider. They worked to help finish our Chapel extension project, which now allows us to seat forty extra people during the Bible conferences and other activities of the year. They also helped paint many areas of the compound including our "living room-meeting room" here in the house (Chuy is especially thankful for that). They also made bunk beds for the new dorm areas. We were blessed by the two preachers who were with the group: Brother Paul Flowers and Gary Palmer, both of whom spoke in Chapel to the students and in local area churches. Shannon Flowers (Paul's wife) was a great blessing to many children as she

shared the Gospel in several Bible Club activities.

Our partners in Medical Evangelism came once again from **Brookwood Baptist Church**, led by missions' pastor **Donny Lee and Dr. Jeff German**. This team of brethren ministered medically in ten different locations while our

translators and students worked beside them, communicating the Word of Salvation to those who came for physical help. Five of the clinics were set up in churches or missions in the **Cordoba** area. Another five clinics were held in the **Chinanteco** area of **Oaxaca**, in the churches in the villages of **Rio Manzo**, **La Soledad**, **La Fuente Misteriosa**, **Loma Bonita** and in the recently started mission work of **Cangrejo**. Through the loving care of these brethren, a powerful message was given of the grace of God and salvation through his Son Jesus Christ. We praise the Lord for these brethren from Brookwood who are instruments of blessing, faithfully serving among us year after year!

This past month, we had another special blessing on campus with the arrival of **Rebecca Danielle**. **Marco and Gina Barroso** are the proud and grateful parents of this precious baby who is a reminder of the
