Now, Juan has graduated and has been serving as the pastor at Santa Maria la Alta for the past six months. God has directed this young man in His





**Dr. Bo Worley** has been a part of MITC for almost fifty years; pulling teeth, flying people down to serve, supporting, serving on the board and blessing many with his love for the Lord Jesus. For many years, he served as the pilot and travel companion for **Bill Stowell**, our mission pastor and conference speaker, until the Lord called Bro. Bill home. Then Bo began bringing a team from **Emmanuel Baptist church**, his home church, in Shreveport LA. He has been leading them down for the last ten years. These brethren have answered the Lord's call to serve each year for a week, doing dental missions and work projects

here at MITC. We take this team out to different sites each day and set up an area with portable dental units and chairs and help many people who do not have access to dental help of any kind. God has used this to open doors to the Gospel in areas where there is still no Christian work or church. The Cordoba authorities have been very supportive of this help and invite us to take these brethren to new communities each time they come. So, praise the Lord, the Word continues to go forth! We are also thankful for pediatric dentist **Dr. Dan Crawford** and his wife **Gretchen**, who complete this team with their skills and love and service to the Lord.



We pray for God's continued guidance for MITC, as we begin this year and the 60th year of serving the Lord here in Mexico.
