The town's people don't want the Good News of the Gospel spreading, because the people "lose their saints" (idols) and no longer get drunk to celebrate the feasts. Pray for these brethren and especially for our student Elia, as she ministers to them in these difficult days.



Cangrejo Believers

God is blessing the new mission work of **Cangrejo**, which started just a few years ago. It is located in the heart of the mountainous **Chinanteco** region of **Oaxaca**. The first believer of this



village was in the United States as a migrant worker, where he heard the Gospel and decided to return to Mexico and share the Good News with his family and relatives. Soon, the Gospel was received by several more of the locals and now, God is



raising up a church for His glory. This past month, brother **Arce** had the blessing of baptizing the most recent believers in Christ in the church at Cangrejo. Thank you for prayers for these brethren and pray that God will continue to give them His peace and growth and soon bring others to the saving knowledge of Christ.

We were blessed to have a new group of "short time" missionaries here on campus, as **Tom Harrison** and his **Sunday School** class from **Broadmoor Baptist Church** came and worked with us last month. It is such a blessing to see brethren who love the Lord be challenged to serve Him outside of their usual surroundings and obey the Great Commission of GOING. During their stay, they helped with many carpentry, painting and construction projects here on campus and participated in worship services in **La Cumbre, Neria** and **El Pochote**. The Lord used each of them in a special way and they were a great encouragement

to our staff and faculty. We look forward to many more times of service and fellowship together in the future.

Once again, the Dental ministry opened opportunities to share the Message of the Lord Jesus, as **Dr. Bo Worley** led the group from Emmanuel Baptist Church down for a week of service. We were invited to have a dental clinic for the town of Peñuela, where over seventy people were seen for dental problems. While the doctors worked, our students shared the Word with young and old, including several government workers who helped set up the clinic. At the end of the day, the mayor and several officials came out to express thanks for what was done. Dr. Bo replied, "We came here because we wanted you to see the love of Jesus. Thank you for this opportunity". One of the officials responded, "That is what happened!

To finish off the month, we had another "medical evangelistic" ministry week as Drs. Powell and Kacy led a team of seventeen medical personnel from Beaumont TX. They helped perform much needed surgeries on forty patients. These surgeries were major gynecological procedures and also general surgery cases, including gall bladders and hernias. Many people from the Cordoba region and also from the mountains of Usila were helped by the doctors. Assisting with the work and praying and sharing the Gospel with the patients and relatives were our Bible students, coordinated by staff member Mary Rodriguez. We housed the patients and families from the mountains here on campus. This allowed further ministry opportunities, as they were lovingly served by the students during their stay. We are especially grateful for the good outcome of Regina (our cook) from her surgery. Overseeing things with the Hospital and the local authorities was our long time friend Dr. Rocio. We thank the Lord for allowing this work and testimony of His great love to many people in our area. We are also thankful for all the doctors that made up the team from the U.S. who lovingly came and served with us here in Mexico.

The purpose in all things is to bring glory to the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and that through this, many would come to know Him as their Hope and Refuge for now and for all eternity! Thank you for making this possible through your love, prayers and support. God uses you so that these ministries and many others here at MITC continue on a daily basis.
