The patients come with relatives who help them before and after surgery, so there are a large number of people here on the mission campus during this time (the surgeries are performed in make-shift operating rooms in our Library and 1st year classroom). While waiting for their turn, they hear the message of the Love of God, through our Savior Jesus Christ. Our students preach and sing in the waiting area and while the patients are in pre-op, they are prayed for by students and doctors. Meanwhile, the

children have Bible clubs, classes and gifts. So the whole school family becomes part of the sight-giving, love and truth-sharing endeavor! Through the years, many have come to know the grace of God through this effort. We praise the Lord for the life and service of **Dr. and Mrs. Tom Robinson**, who spearhead this effort and for all those who work alongside of them, both from the U.S. and from here in Mexico! May the Lord add much blessing and fruit to this work of love in His Name!
