Youth Camp

In the month of May, we had our Vacation Bible School Workshop with sister Linda Webb. During July, we had our main month for holding these VBS in many churches throughout southern Mexico. More than fifty weeks of VBS were held by students, staff and alumni in different churches. The teachings of God's working by His Spirit in the early church and the ministry of the Apostles, "flew" from village to village as the children boarded a "plane" to fly to Jerusalem, Antioch, Ephesus and Rome. At each location, they learned of the testimony of the Gospel through the first New Testament believers. The children were also challenged to share the

Word of Jesus. In every place, many children from non-believing households attended and brought their mothers with them. So, the Gospel message spread into many new homes through this ministry throughout the states of **Veracruz, Oaxaca, Puebla, Tabasco** and **Chiapas**. We also had our annual "on campus" VBS for the neighborhood children, 90 percent coming from non-believing homes. Once again this year, the Lord blessed in a great way, bringing nearly 100 children each day to the VBS. **Brother Alfredo Arce** headed up this effort, working with special VBS workers from **Delhi Hills Bible Chapel**, led by **Kara Landis**. While the kids were in VBS, we had a crafts class and Bible study each day for the more than twenty-five moms who came to bring their children. We are grateful for this special time of ministry. The rest of the team from Delhi Hills helped with construction projects and shared in the ministry of local churches in the area.

Our privilege and responsibility to share the Gospel was the main theme in this year's Youth Camp titled "Mission Possible". **Preacher Bill Britt** presented the Gospel and challenged all to seek the Lord's empowering to

bravely obey and share the Gospel of salvation in Christ through repentance and Faith in Him alone. The biographies of many of God's servants of the past were used to motivate the minds of the youth attending, teaching that no sacrifice is too great when done for the Glory of God and His Gospel. Also illustrating this powerful Message was the youth group from Community Harvest Church led by Pastor Danny Giltner. These brethren presented dramas and also served in the kitchen, helping us feed around 300 people each day. God worked among us in a special way as many hearts were touched by the Word and several youth sought counsel regarding the call to surrender to full time ministry. We thank the Lord for Jimmy Vazquez, our camp director and all the students and alumni who help staff this special week of the summer.

Please pray with us regarding the start of the new school year as we depend on God for all
